Prayer of Welcome

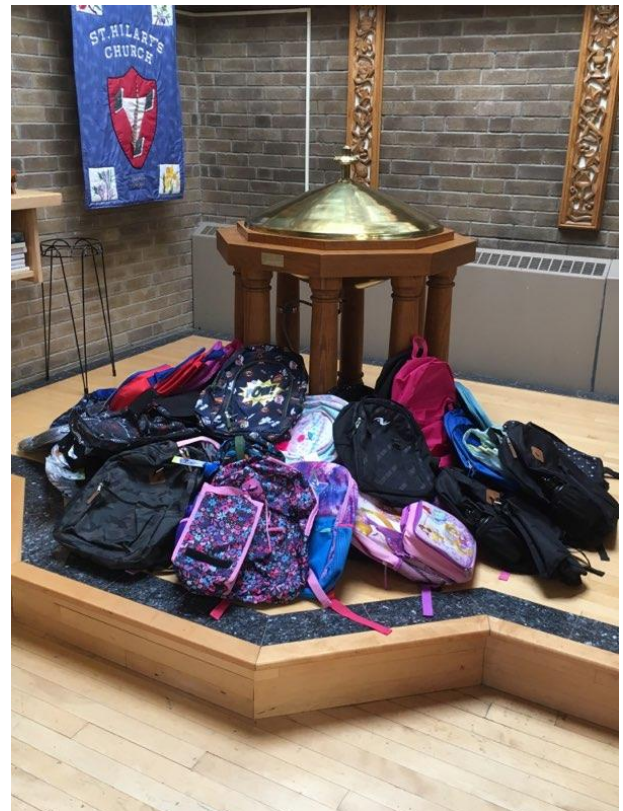
Lord, our God, source of all life,
